The Via Dolorosa, or in Latin "The Sorrowful Way," is a physical walk in Jerusalem which remembers Jesus' journey to the Cross. Over the centuries, countless Christians have symbolically walked the Sorrowful Way in Lent by doing the Stations the Cross, which marks important moments from Jesus' last earthly journey.
